### ADMISSIONS PROCESS - ALL APPLICANTS

- Educational Consultation
- Online Application
- Recent Report Card or School Transcripts
- Standardized Test Scores (FSA, PSAT, CAT, ITBS, MAP, etc.)
- At least one teacher recommendation
- Student Essay (grades 6-12 only), from prompt included in the Online Application
- Educational/Diagnostic or Psychological Evaluation Results (IEP, 504, etc.), if applicable

### ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The student must be at least 16 years old.</li><li>• The student must be entering grade 10 or above.</li><li>• The student must have above average English proficiency.</li><li>• The international student's guardian must have permanent or established residency in the United States. A visitor's visa does not meet this requirement.</li></ul> <p><i>The Rock School does not provide boarding or host families. All living arrangements are the responsibility of the student's family.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• School Transcripts, translated to English</li><li>• Student's Passport information page</li><li>• Proof of Funds documentation (bank statement and/or letter of support)</li><li>• Local guardian contact information, if student will live with someone other than the parents</li><li>• Email address for at least one current teacher who can complete a recommendation form</li><li>• Zoom Interview, to assess English proficiency</li></ul>
