Getting Started

We are so honored that you have decided to apply to The Rock School! We know that applications can be tedious and time-consuming, but we have done our best to streamline this process to be as simple as possible. Gather these documents before getting started:

- Recent Report Card or School Transcripts
- Standardized Test Scores (FSA, PSAT, CAT, ITBS, MAP, etc.)
- Educational/Diagnostic or Psychological Evaluation Results (IEP, 504, etc.), if applicable
- Email address for at least one current teacher who can complete a recommendation form

How to Apply

To begin, visit www.therocklions.com/apply and create an account. After creating an account, you will receive an email containing a verification link. Follow the directions in the email to verify your email.

Log in to your account and **Create A New Student Application** for your child. (You will then have the flexibility to log in and out of your account and access your open application.) Submit the completed application and pay the \$25 non-refundable application fee per student.

Track your admissions status and monitor when the school receives any applicable supplemental forms by logging in to your account.

January 15 - Deadline to submit applications for first round of consideration

February - First round of admissions decisions sent

April 15 - Deadline to submit applications for second round of consideration
