

Preschool Application Process | AGES 0-4

How to Apply

If you already have other siblings enrolled in The Rock Preschool or The Rock School, please follow the Sibling Application Guide to apply for a new sibling. Contact admissions@therock.school if you need assistance.

For new family/new student applications, visit **www.therocklions.com/apply** and create an account. After creating an account, you will receive an email containing a verification link. Follow the directions in the email to verify your email. Then log in to your account and **Create A New Student Application** for your child. (You will then have the flexibility to log in and out of your account and access your open application.) Submit the completed application and pay the \$30 non-refundable application fee per student.

What Happens Next

Demand for admissions is unprecedented. Tours and Educational Consultations will only be offered to families who have completed applications and we have a projected opening in that grade level. Tour invitations will be sent after each application deadline, depending on projected openings, with notice of enrollment status to be sent within 2-3 weeks of your appointment.

November - Application Opens

December 1 - Deadline for Early Application window for siblings

January 15 - Deadline to submit applications for first round of consideration

April 15 - Deadline to submit applications for second round of consideration
